

Headsheets

Portrait-realistic, blank head templates for learners to draw on — front, profile, back and top views. Designed for sectioning practice, foil placement, cutting plans, hairline mapping and client consultations. The images are printed at a soft tone so your pencil and pen sit cleanly on top.

Why headsheets are useful

- **See the whole head before you cut.** Drawing your plan first stops you reacting section-by-section and helps you keep the overall shape.
- **Build your eye for shape.** Repeated drawing trains you to spot graduation, weight lines, the parietal ridge and the occipital bone — the landmarks every cut sits around.
- **Plan colour cleanly.** Map foil placement, slices, balayage sweeps and root areas before you mix — fewer mistakes on the head.
- **Communicate clearly.** A quick sketch turns a vague consultation into a shared picture, so the client sees exactly what they're getting.
- **Evidence your work.** Headsheets sit perfectly in your portfolio alongside before/after photos — brilliant for assessments and end-point reviews.
- **Revise faster.** Working through classic cuts and colour techniques on paper locks in the steps before you ever pick up scissors.

How to use

- Print at A4 — keep a stack in your folder.
- Pencil in your sections first, then refine in pen.
- Label every sheet with client name, date and service.
- Keep completed sheets — they make brilliant revision material before assessments.

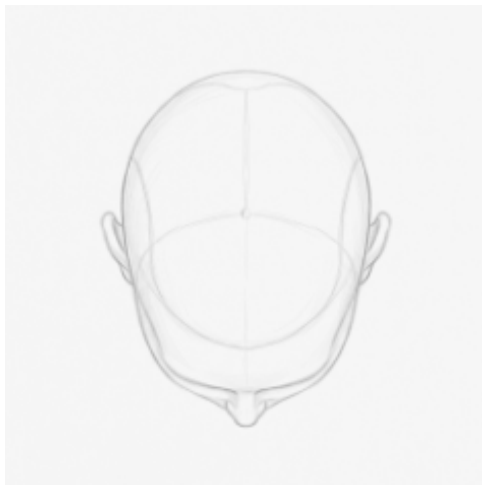

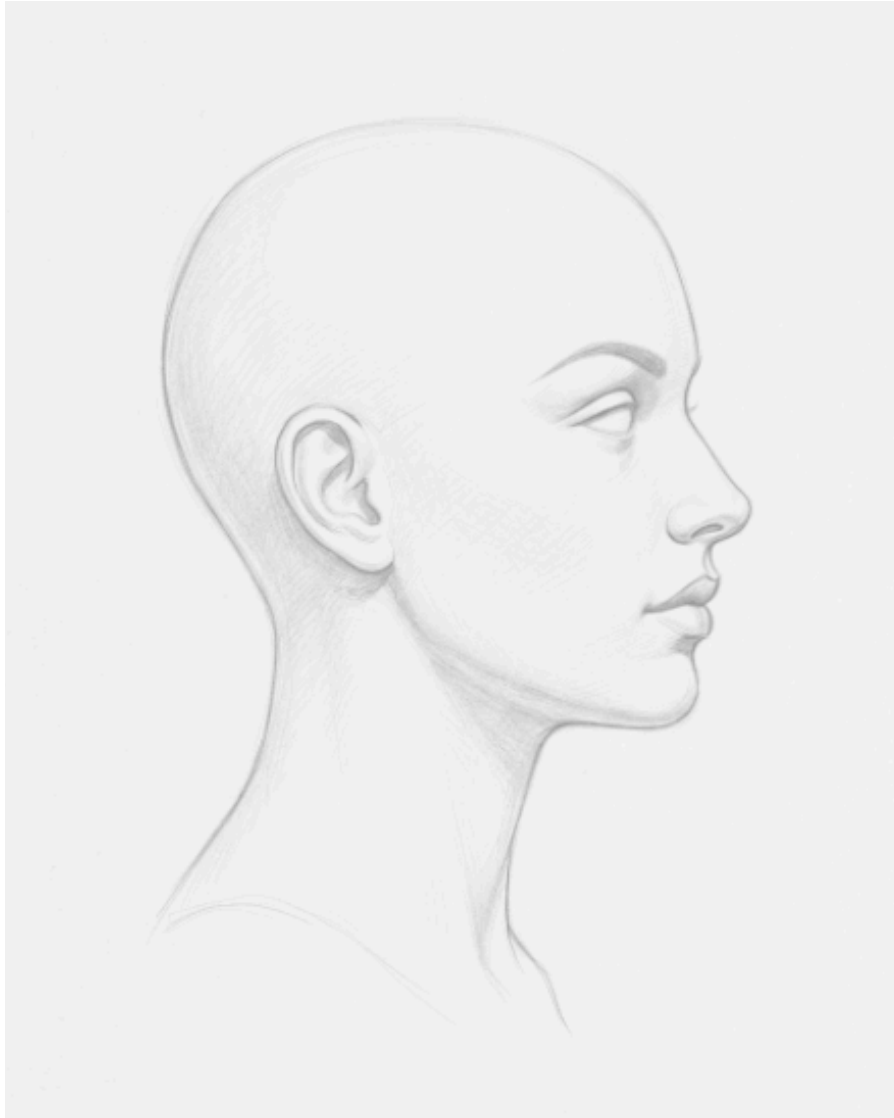
